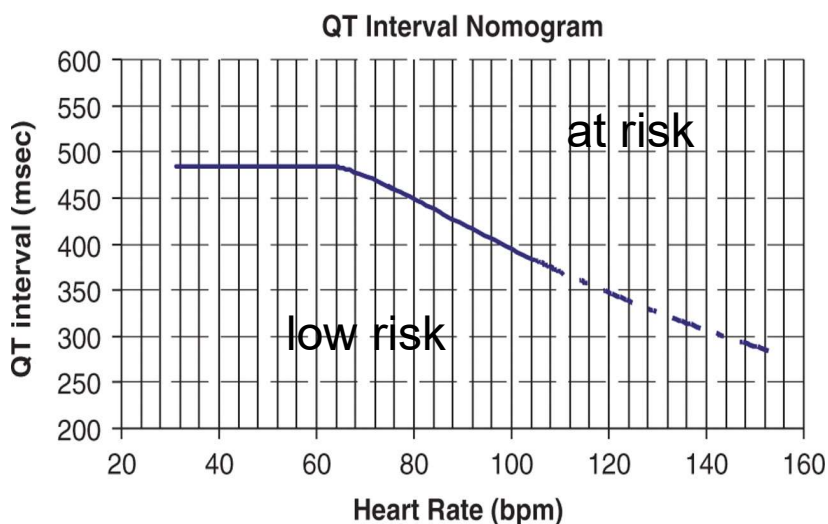
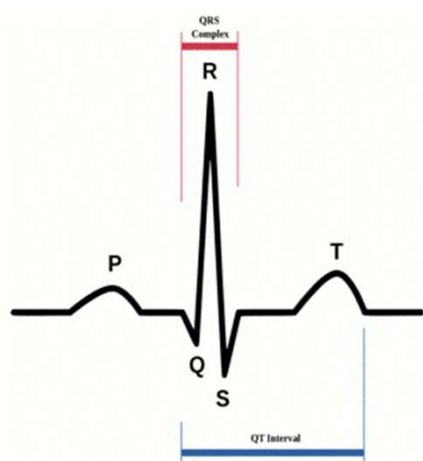


TOX6 within 30 minutes for unwell patients

1. Ensure clear airway, consider antidotes (e.g. naloxone)
2. Check blood sugar
3. If hypotensive - boluses of fluid up to 20ml/kg.
4. If QRS >120, give 8.4% NaHCO₃, 50 ml, repeat bolus to max pH 7.55
5. If QT "at risk" on ECG (see below) give 2g MgSO₄ (also check K⁺)
6. If agitation or serotonin toxicity give 20mg diazepam.

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Severe poisoning

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Notes –

Severe **hypotension** – consider toxicity from calcium channel or β - blockers

Severe **pyrexia (temp >39°C)** – consider serotonin toxicity

Severe **acidosis** – consider toxic alcohols
