

CLINICAL GUIDELINE

Rescue Airway Trolley, Emergency Department, Glasgow Royal Infirmary

A guideline is intended to assist healthcare professionals in the choice of disease-specific treatments.

Clinical judgement should be exercised on the applicability of any guideline, influenced by individual patient characteristics. Clinicians should be mindful of the potential for harmful polypharmacy and increased susceptibility to adverse drug reactions in patients with multiple morbidities or frailty.

If, after discussion with the patient or carer, there are good reasons for not following a guideline, it is good practice to record these and communicate them to others involved in the care of the patient.

MacIntosh Blades: Size 2, 3 & 4

Gum Elastic Bougie: Medium & Large

Drawer/ Plan B

iGel Size 3 & 4 & 5 Aintree Catheter Size 7mm Endotracheal Tube

Swivel Connector for Aintree Catheter

Drawer/Plan C

Face Masks: 1 of each adult size OP Airways: 2 of each adult size

NP Airways: 1 of each size Sugammadex 4 of 500g Sugammadex Dosing Chart

Drawer/Plan D

Size 6mm Endotracheal Tube Gum Elastic Bougie Tracheal Hook

Scalpel

Bottom Drawer

Nebuliser & Adrenaline 1mg in 1ml Lignocaine & Phenylephrine Xylocaine Spray
