# Referral to Chalmers Centre for management/follow-up of positive results.

Positive results on tests for sexually transmitted infection and blood-borne viruses can be referred to the sexual health team at the Chalmers centre for management and onward referral.

• The patient can be given the diagnosis by the ED clinician and advised that the Chalmers team will be in touch.

OR

• Where this is not possible, or the ED clinician does not feel confident in giving the diagnosis by phone, the Chalmers team can contact the patient and arrange for follow up.

## For high priority and urgent results:

- New HIV diagnosis
- Untreated positive syphilis serology or syphilis PCR
- Untreated gonorrhoea
- Infectious hepatitis B
