

Going to the Emergency Department (ED) at the Royal Hospital for Children and Young People (RHCYP)

The address of the hospital is 50 Little France Crescent, Edinburgh Bio Quarter, Edinburgh, EH16 4TJ.

However, sat navs using this address will usually direct you to the MAIN ENTRANCE of the hospital; the emergency department is on the other side and is easier to get to by entering the hospital site via GATE 2 (circled on map below), rather than the main gate (gate 1).

The QR code below will take you to a pin which, if used with google maps navigation, will take you straight to the emergency department.

Written driving directions from St John's Hospital

- Take the M8 eastbound from junction 3 (Livingston) towards Edinburgh.
- At the Hermiston Gait roundabout, exit onto the A720 City Bypass South.
- At the Sheriffhall roundabout, exit onto Old Dalkeith Road (A7).
- Follow signs to the NHS Lothian Hospital campus.

About the Emergency Department at RHCYP

- **Entrance**: Follow signs from Gate 2 (signposted from Old Dalkeith Road). Follow RED Accident & Emergency signs if travelling by car or taxi.
- Parking: Short-stay drop-off and free long-stay visitor parking available.
- Reception: Check in on arrival for initial details and triage assessment.
- Waiting Times: Patients are seen based on the severity of their condition.
- Facilities: Toys, games, and TVs available to keep children occupied.
